


Bridge Cables

Passerelle des Neigles (Fribourg, Swiss)

The bridge was constructed in 1878 as a suspension footbridge crossing over the Saane river that runs through Fribourg city. Since the steel main cables, which were introduced in 1951, degraded and corroded, they were replaced with CFCC. The bridge rehabilitated many times and becomes a symbol of the city.


